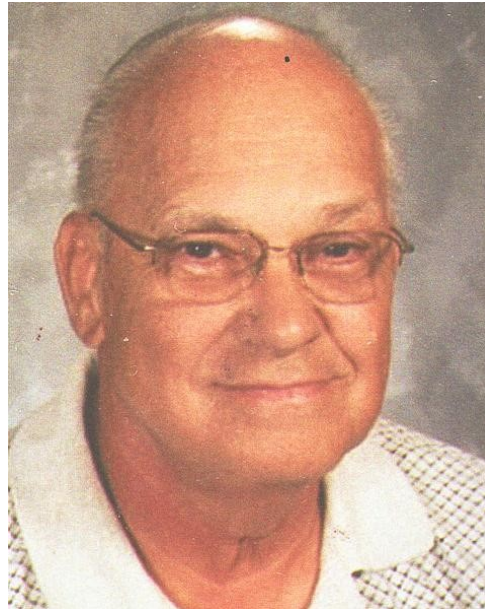

LOCKPORT — Edward Veihdeffer, 70 years old, died May 17, 2011, at Niagara House in Lockport. He was born in Hyde, PA on July 13, 1940, the son of the late Charles Veihdeffer. Mr. Veihdeffer moved to Niagara Falls as an infant and was a graduate of Niagara Falls High School. Mr. Veihdeffer served with the United States Army from April 23, 1962 until his honorable discharge on April 22, 1968.

He worked as a tinsmith at Harrison Radiator for 29 years and retired in 1999. After his retirement he worked at Edu-Tech for nine years. He was a Ham Radio Operator KM2Q and was a member of the Sunday Flyers, an amateur model airplane building and flying club. He was a NASCAR fan and enjoyed fishing.
